Regular Classes

Regular classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include: Puppy, 6 months to under 9 months; Puppy, 9 months to under 12 months; Junior, 12 months to under 15 months; Junior 15 months to under 18 months; Bred-by-Exhibitor; American Bred; Open (Long-haired); Open (Shorthaired); Winners; Best of Breed Competition

Bred By Exhibitor Eligibility

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- The persons handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Non-Regular Classes

Best Bred-By Exhibitor

Best bred-by exhibitor involves the winners of the Bred-By Exhibitor classes. Even if one dog or bitch has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, both return to the ring for the judging. This is a separate non-regular class. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on this award.

Best Puppy

Best puppy involves the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 puppy classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four puppy class winners return to the ring for the judging of best puppy. This is a separate non-regular class. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the best puppy award.

Veteran Classes

Veteran Classes will be held just after Winners for their respective sex. Veteran Dogs and Bitches must be seven (7) years of age or older. 1st Place Veteran Dog and 1st Place Veteran Bitch are eligible for Best Of Breed. Chapter 11 Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows states: "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed." Therefore neutered dogs and spayed bitches 7 years of age or older will be eligible for this class. The winners of Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch classes will compete for Best Veteran in the Best Of Breed Ring

The following is excerpted from the AKC Sanctioned Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition Regulations

Amended by AKC Board of Directors October 2019 (effective February 7, 2020)

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.

All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handles, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 and an AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2). This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition to its acceptance.

RETURNED OR POST DATED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Northern New Jersey Saint Bernard Club will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
